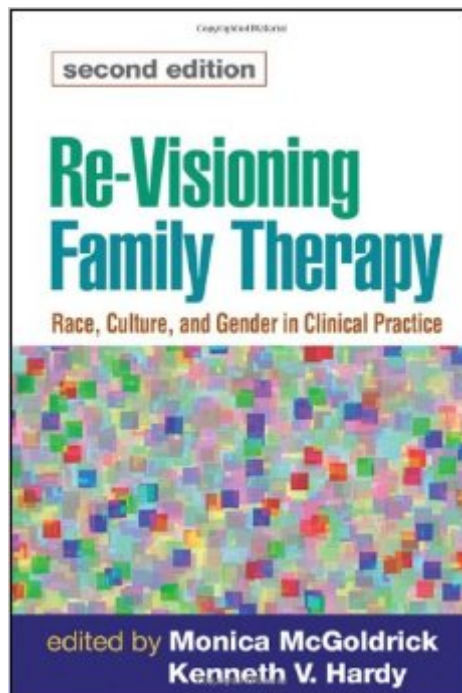

Hardy and McGoldrick point that it is necessary to consider that dominant ideologies have deep impact in the family therapists interventions and comprehension of the interpersonal dynamics of families. The chapters offer many provocative reflections about ways to reconsider our preconceptions. The book offers a review of main stream family therapy in order to actualize it in a society more democratic and with multiple cultural backgrounds.
